

## **Pulmonary Embolism - High Risk Case (score >6)**

### "Near Live" Usability Testing

History (Standardized patient):

Provider: "Hi, what brings you in today?"

*Patient is in mild distress due to shortness of breath and increased heart rate.*

Patient: "I am having difficulty breathing. During the past 1 hour, I have developed acute onset of shortness of breath. I was going through my usual routine of making breakfast, not doing anything out of the ordinary and not exercising, going up and down stairs, or walking great distances.

I just had knee surgery on my right leg. I've been less active since the surgery, mostly just walking from bed to sofa and kitchen for the past week. I noticed some swelling of the right lower leg a few days ago too."

Physical Exam (Provided in written form):

T 99, HR 105, Lungs: CTABL, Ext: RLE edema
